I. Estate Planning, Trust & Probate Law Section

John D. Clark of the Estate Planning, Trust and Probate Law Section explained the proposed statute. To add ORC section 5802.04 so as to clarify and confirm when the terms of a trust may direct that the trustee and/or beneficiaries must settle disputes by arbitration.

The proposal follows the example put forward by ACTEC and also follows the current statutes in Florida and Arizona.

Through questioning, Mr. Clark pointed out:

- that there is no current Ohio case law on this issue,
- that the proposal allows the settlor to set the terms of the arbitration and does not foreclose the use of mediation, and

• that the statute is working well in Florida and Arizona.

C. Keith Plummer, District 15, moved the proposal, seconded by Frederick C. Fisher, District 8, and carried unanimously that the proposal be favorably recommended to the Council of Delegates.
