ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter is before the Court in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis.

This Order is effective March 17, 2020, and until further order of the Court.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that no attorney, litigant, and/or member of the public, shall enter or remain in the Richland County Common Pleas Court/Administrative Building if ANY of the following apply:


1. He or she has a fever;
2. He or she exhibits all three of the following symptoms: a) respiratory symptoms (chronic cough), b) sore throat, and c) shortness of breath.
3. He or she has traveled out of the country within the last 14 days;
4. He or she has been in contact with a person who is under investigation or has tested positive for COVID-19.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all individuals entering the Richland County Common Pleas Court/Administrative Building shall be subject to health care screening or non-invasive testing (the taking of body temperature using a touch-free thermometer), and exclusion from admission based upon the results of such screening or testing.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all individuals shall maintain appropriate social distancing of 6-10 feet where possible.


This Order shall be posted conspicuously throughout the Richland County Common Pleas Court/Administrative Building and on the Court's website.


